DECORUM ORDER FOR MEDIA


In the interests of justice, for the safety of individuals attending the preliminary hearing in the above-entitled case and to ensure the fairness and integrity of the hearing, the Court orders as follows:

1. All members of the media are to display official court and media credentials at all times.
2. Interviews and/or press conferences can be conducted only in designated areas.
3. Witnesses and attorneys are not to be contacted, filmed or photographed in the courthouse.
4. Exterior video and still cameras are permitted only in previously designated areas.
5. All wires and cables, outside the courthouse, are to be secured or covered. This wiring and cabling is to be arranged in a manner that does not impede vehicular and pedestrian traffic outside the courthouse.
6. Positioning of exterior video and still cameras is subject to modification by the Court as deemed necessary.

7. Reporters, photographers, videographers and audio technicians are permitted only in designated areas.
 8. Media vehicles, including personal vehicles, are not to be parked illegally.
 9. No cameras, tape recorders, video recorders, camcorders, laptops or other computers cellular phones, personal digital assistants, satellite phones or any other manual or electronic device capable of recording video, audio or still images, or any devices capable of recording video, audio or still images, nor any device capable of transmitting any visual or audio representation or actual image or sound will be permitted in the courtroom or listening room.
 10. Cellular phones cannot be used in the courtroom or listening room. Pagers will be allowed only in the listening room.
 11. All media personnel failing to occupy their respective seats in the courtroom within 15 minutes of the beginning of the morning or afternoon -sessions will forfeit their seat for the remainder of that particular session and the seat will be released to other media representatives.
 12. Failure to comply with this order will result in the offending party being denied access to the listening room and the courtroom and may result in the listening room being closed.

Violation of this order may also result in the offending party being held in contempt of court and subject to monetary sanctions pursuant to CCP §177. 5
